The Culver City Rain Garden is a Low Impact Development (LID) project that captures and infiltrates storm water runoff from the adjacent industrial parking lots and streets, removing harmful pollutants and metals before reaching Ballona Creek. The garden is planted with native riparian vegetation to enhance water quality, provide habitat for native birds and wildlife, as well as beautify this stretch of Ballona Creek.

The Garden is located at the end of Pearson Street off of Jefferson Blvd. **Come learn about the garden while helping us remove and control invasive weeds.** Tools and gloves will be provided.

Please wear sturdy shoes and clothes to get dirty, bring water and sunscreen.
