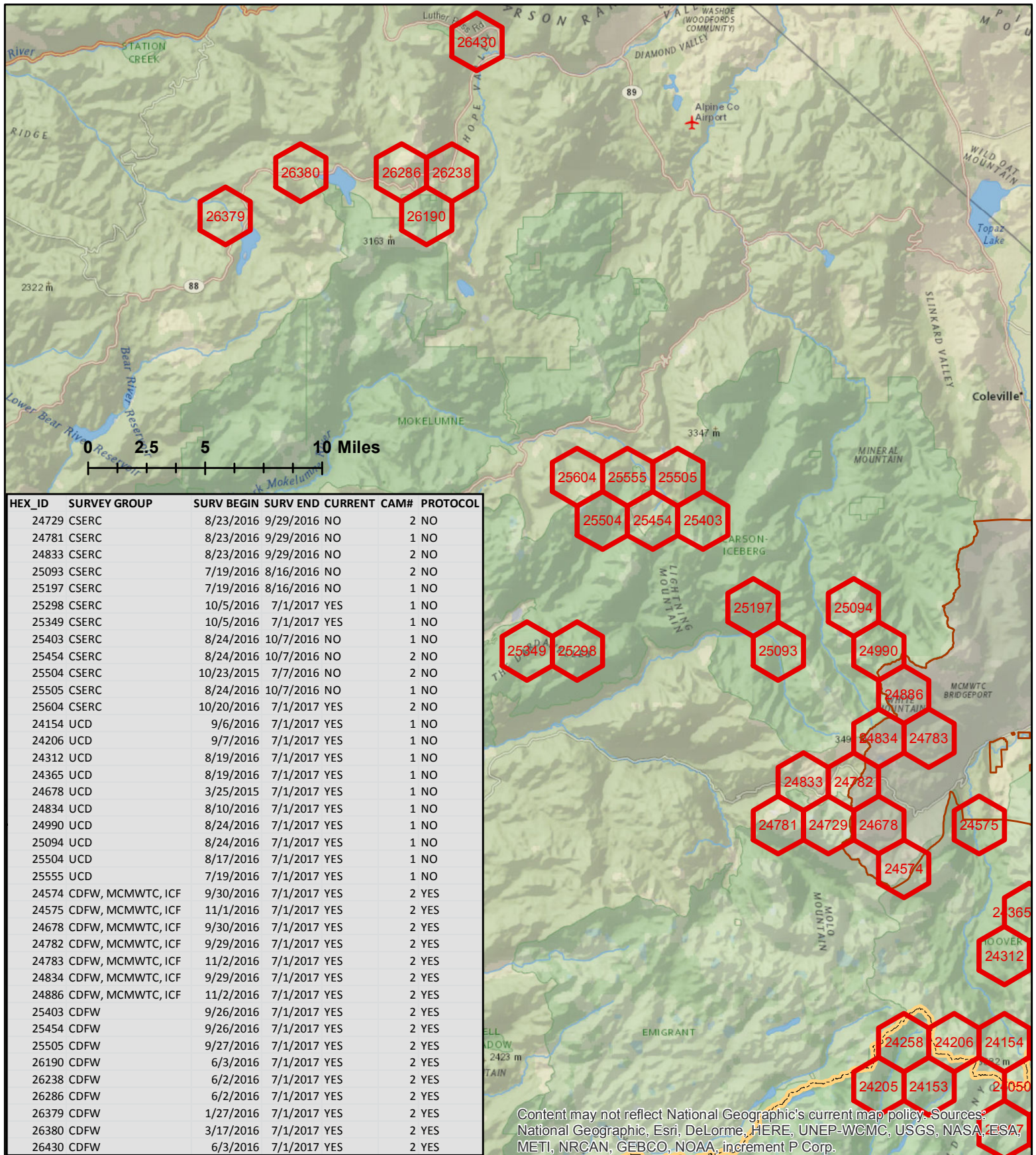


## 2016-2017 Predator (SNRF) Surveys in the Sierra Nevada DPS (Northern Range - Version 11/9/2016)

Note: This map indicates where researchers are using camera traps to target the detection of the SNRF in the Sierra Nevada DPS. Preferably surveys use the protocol endorsed by the SNRF Working Group, which will help determine the true distribution of the species throughout this range. This protocol includes using two cameras per 4 sq mile hexagon, set a minimum of a mile apart, with hair snare devices to collect genetic samples.
