Need a passcode to enter the property. From the south: Take Hwy 101 north to the River Rd./Mark West Springs Rd. exit near Fulton. Turn left onto River Rd. and travel west. - SCWA installs boom in front of dam when dam is inflated and takes the boom down when it is deflated.
