Site history, stand age, comments: <u>STAND OF MATURE REDWOOD AND MADRONE ON SOUTHWEST FACING SLOPE FORMING A RING AROUND A RING FIR/MADRONE STAND DIRECTLY UP HILL. UNDERSTORY HAS CONSIDERABLE REDWOOD BASEAL RESPROUT, BUT IS OTHERWISE SPARSELY VEGETATED WITH HONEY SUCKLE, ASH, AND A FEW MADRONE SEEDLINGS. PLOT HAS REDWOOD GUMBLE FROM 15-20 YR OLD GRADUAL LOGGING, WHICH SHOWS CLEAR. FIRE EVENT NOT RECENT - NO SIGN ON GROWING STEMS. ADJACENT PLOT TO THE WEST HAS SIGN OF RECENT LOGGING, INCLUDING SLASH, WASTE LOGS, AND DRAG AND FOOT TRAMPLE SOIL DISTURBANCE.</u>
