Site history, stand age, comments: CANYON LIVE OAK, COASTAL LIVE OAK, MADRONE, AND BAY LEAF growing just east of SARATOGA GAP PARKING LOT. BOUNDED BY HWY 9 TO THE NORTH AND SKYLINE BLVD TO THE SOUTH AND BISECTED BY THE SKYLINE TO SEATTLE. THIS PLANT HAS A SPARSLEY VEGETATED UNDERSTORY DOMINATED MOSTLY BY POISON OAK, MONEY SUCKLE, AND SHRUBBY TAN OAK AND LIVE OAK SEEDLINGS. FERNS, ILIS ARE ALSO PRESENT. BIG LEAF MAPLE, DOG FIRM BOTH HAVE SIGNIFICANT 1% COVER. BUCKEYE WOULD HAVE SLIGHTLY HIGHER 1% COVER BUT IS DECIDUOUS. SAME WITH POISON OAK.
