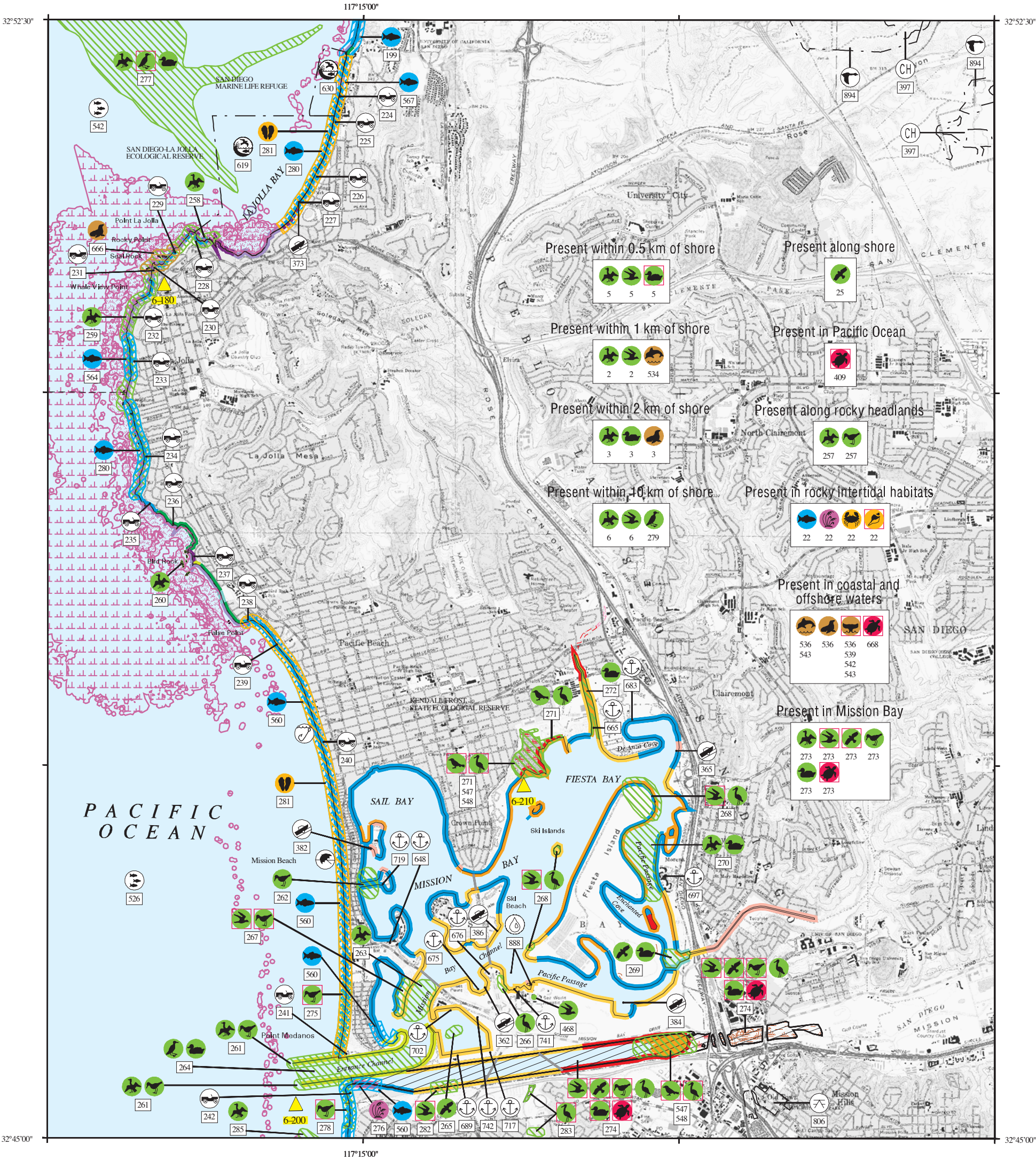
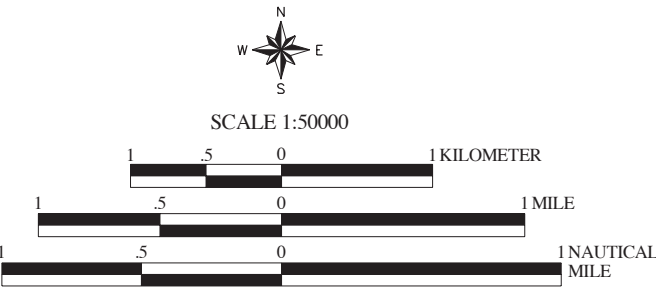


ENVIRONMENTAL SENSITIVITY INDEX MAP

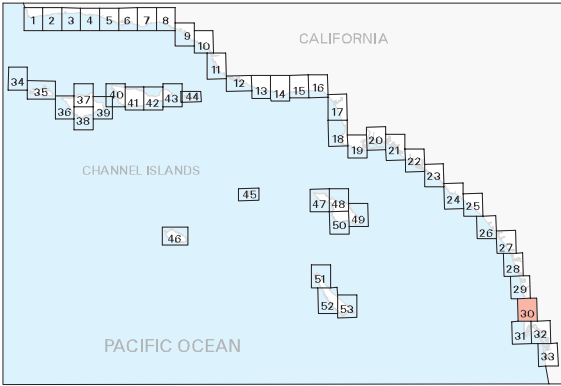
