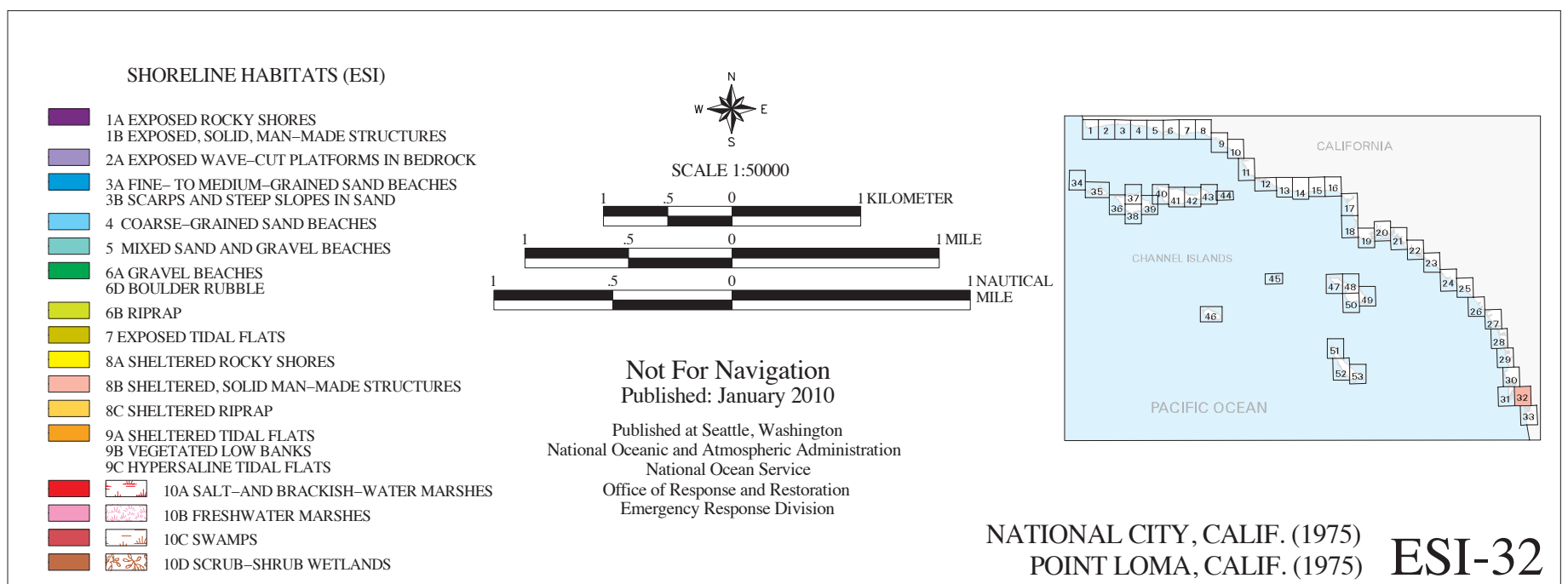
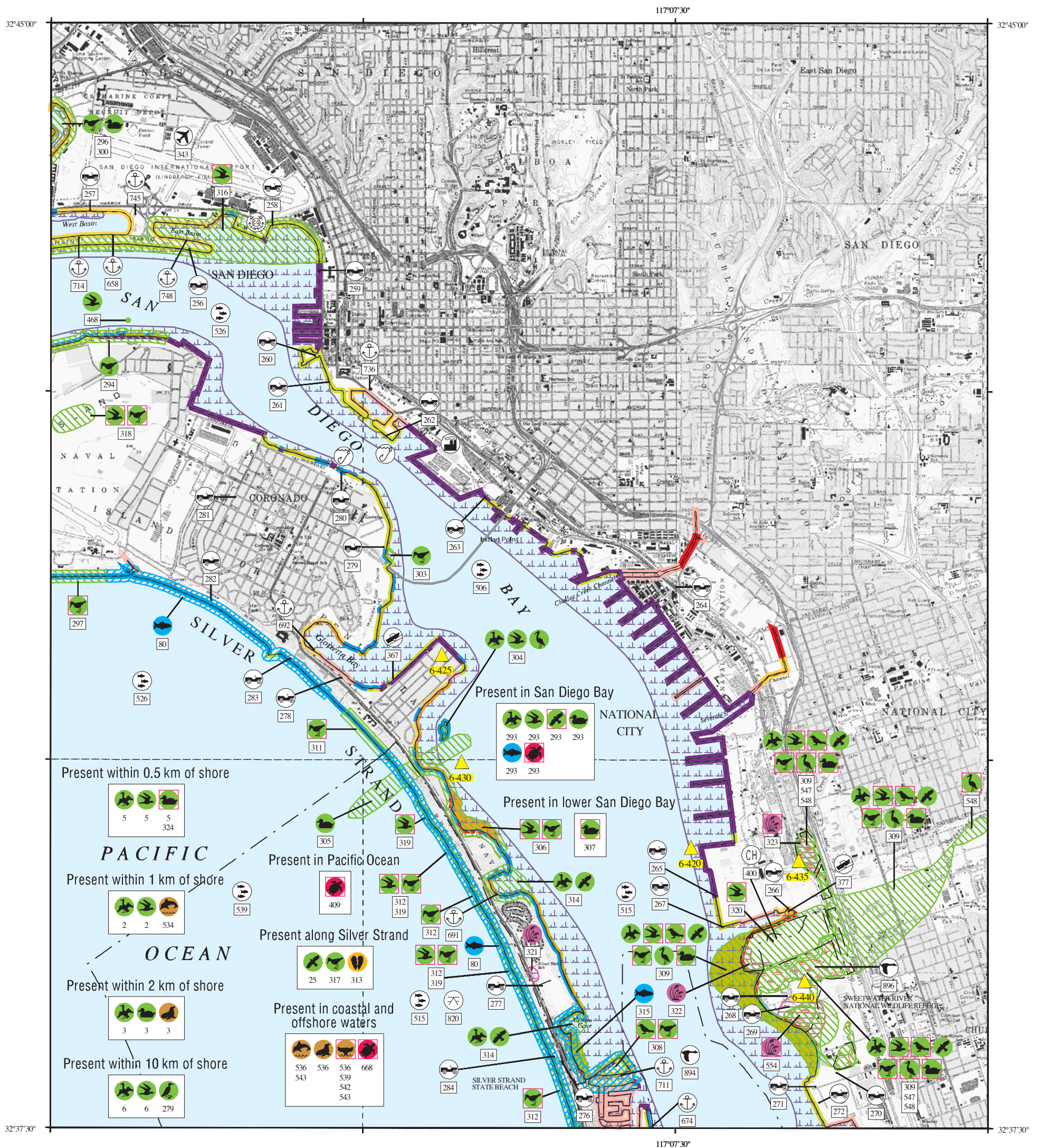


ENVIRONMENTAL SENSITIVITY INDEX MAP
